- 1. Raise vehicle and support with safety stands.
- Mount tie rod bracket using U-bolts supplied. (See Illustration A). 2.
- Turn wheels to full right and mount cylinder onto the tie rod mount. Now pull cylinder to full extension. З.
- Mount frame mount onto cylinder shaft. (See Illustration B) 4.
- 5. Check to see that wheels are still full right and the cylinder is full extension. Measure cylinder shaft and push in $1/2^{"}$.
- 6. Position mount on center support crossmember and clamp into place.
- 7. Mark the 3 mounting holes and then drill with a 11/32" drill. Note: On some trucks a steel coolant line may be in line of drill path. Simply remove mounting bolts and move out of the way. Replace when driling is done.
- 8. Bolt bracket into place and tighten bolts to 25 ft./lbs.
- 9. Check full wheel movement by turning wheels full right to left, lock to lock.
- 10. Periodically inspect the assembly for tightness.
